The Joplin Trails Coalition is a nonprofit organization dedicated to creating a regional trail network by converting abandoned railroad lines to multi use trails. (Rails to Trails) We currently have 2 trails; the 3.5 mile Frisco Greenway and the 16 mile Ruby Jack. The Ruby Jack's 8 eastern miles are complete. While the 8 western miles are open, care should be taken. Both trails offer long stretches of uninterrupted pathway with occasional street crossings. The trails are lined with trees, bushes and wildflowers providing scenic greenbelt parks. The trails are created and maintained via the hard work of several volunteers and generous donations from individuals and businesses throughout the community. We invite you to come and explore the trails in person and to get involved by joining the Joplin Trails Coalition. While much of our costs are covered by grants, we are required to match a certain percentage. We depend heavily on local financial support. Please join today.
